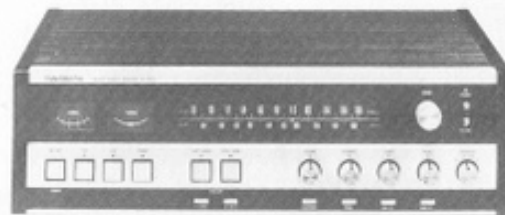

All the most important functions are yours in this FM-only receiver. It delivers 55 watts RMS continuously per channel, both channels driven into 8 ohms with no more than 0.15% distortion over 20 Hz to 20,000 Hz. Delayed diode switching gives smooth fade-out/fade-in effect when switching from one program source to another. Tape copy, tape contour facilities and two transcription inputs are ideal for the most demanding owner.

For the tape recordist, each source is capable of being pre-set on the same listening level...provides a momentary fade-out, fade-in when switching from one program source to another. Other sublime features of the TR 2075 are the tape dubbing facilities as well as the facility for using tone controls to rebalance or recontour a recording being made on the third tape recorder. The sound quality of this unit is crystal clear and undistorted...you must hear it.
